Registration of participants will take place at the Vienna International Centre (Gate I) on Monday, 22 June 2009 starting at 08:00 a.m. Participants should bring with them identification documents and this letter to facilitate their entry to the premises and to ensure prompt registration.

The registration desk will be open during working hours (08:00 – 16:00 hrs) from Monday, 22 June to Friday, 26 June 2009. Due to the large number of participants attending, participants are strongly advised to register as early as possible.

Speakers scheduled for Monday are kindly requested to contact the conference desk outside the conference room to upload their presentation immediately after registration. All other speakers should contact the conference desk as soon as possible but at least 24 hours before their presentation is due.

Posters: Posters should be put up on Monday morning, 22 June and should be removed before Friday, 26 June lunch time. Maximum size of the posters: A0 portrait (0.85 m x 1.20 m). Those presenting a poster will be notified in a letter about their poster number. When putting up the poster please only use the space indicated by this number.

Proceedings: The proceedings will be published in the IAEA as soon as possible after the symposium.
