The necessity for international cooperation

 Information exchanges are to be promoted at international level, especially in the fields of safety and economics, which are of common importance.

IAEA as a coordinator on the international cooperation

- Information exchange between seniors and young generations should be promoted on the platform of IAEA.
- The information exchange should focus on not only the technology transfer between generations but also the seniors' experiences.
- As well as the opportunities to contact seniors through conferences, working with seniors is effective for the knowledge transfer. IAEA should provide these two opportunities simultaneously for young generations.
