

Exhibition opportunities during the Symposium on International Safeguards: Linking Strategy, Implementation and People

The IAEA is organizing the International Symposium on International Safeguards: Linking Strategy, Implementation and People in Vienna, Austria, from 20 to 24 October 2014.

The purpose of the symposium is to foster constructive dialogue and information exchange between the IAEA Secretariat, IAEA Member States, nuclear industry representatives and technical experts with a view to exploring jointly the strategic and technical issues facing the IAEA's Department of Safeguards and to discussing the implementation of possible solutions by the safeguards community as a whole. More than 600 participants from IAEA Member States and international organizations are expected to attend the symposium.

It is planned to hold an exhibition in conjunction with the symposium. In the exhibition IAEA Member States and vendors will highlight the latest developments in technologies for IAEA safeguard's application. These technologies include surveillance equipment such as cameras, sealing systems, equipment for destructive and non-destructive assay, environmental sampling, integrated information/communication systems, information analysis and new training techniques. The exhibition will also provide a dedicated demonstration area for use by exhibitors.
