

Exhibition opportunities during the Technical Meeting on the Development of Nuclear Instrumentation for In Situ Environmental Monitoring Programmes

The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is organizing a **Technical Meeting on the Development of Nuclear Instrumentation for In Situ Environmental Monitoring Programmes** to be held at the IAEA's Headquarters in Vienna (Austria) from **30 November – 4 December 2015**

Approximately 50 participants from IAEA Member States and international organizations are expected to attend the meeting. In order to highlight the latest developments in the fields related to environmental monitoring, site characterisation, mobile instrumentation and in-situ measurement methodologies, the IAEA is planning to establish an exhibition space for vendors in these fields during the meeting. The meeting and the exhibition will take place at the Vienna International Centre.

The IAEA does not charge an exhibitor fee. While every effort to include interested vendors will be made, in view of physical space limitations, companies will be served on a basis of relevance and prioritised as '**first come first served**' basis. To allow for timely preparation, all requests for participation should be made before **25 September 2015**.

Please note that should exhibitors wish to be registered as meeting participants, they must follow the normal participation procedures as described under the conference announcement.
