The purpose of the symposium is to review and revisit the foundational principles of isotope hydrology, which is now recognized as an applied discipline in its own right. The symposium also aims to present recent developments and practical applications in the field of isotope hydrology and related fields that can contribute to a better understanding of the water cycle. These applications include water resources assessment and management, the study of past and future changes in the Earth's climate, and the prediction of climate impacts on the water cycle, as well as forensic applications in ecological, wildlife, and food source traceability.

More than 250 participants from IAEA Member States and organizations are expected to attend.

To highlight the latest analytical and measurement developments in the fields of Isotope Hydrology and hydrological sciences, it is planned to hold an exhibition with vendors in these fields in conjunction with the symposium.
