**Registration:** No registration fee required.

Participants are required to wear ID badges at all times while they are on the IAEA premises. Photo ID badges are issued by the UN Security and Safety Service. Badges must be obtained before entry is allowed into the VIC, and are issued at the following location:

At the Vienna International Centre (VIC), **Gate 1** on:

**Sunday, 31 May 2015, 15:00 hrs – 19:00 hrs**

**Monday, 1 June 2015, from 08:00 to 16:00 hrs** and throughout the week from 08:00 to 16:00 hrs.

**Note that issuing of badges is very time consuming; participants are strongly encouraged to register on Sunday afternoon.** For those arriving Monday morning, expect long lines at entry Gate 1, not only for badges but for basic security screening similar to airports. We recommend that you arrive **at least one hour before** the symposium opening each day, especially if a badge is required.

Please bring official identification documents with photo ID (e.g. passport) to facilitate the registration and ID process.
