Opportunities for Exhibitors

The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) is organizing an **International Conference on the IAEA Technical Cooperation Programme: Sixty Years and Beyond – Contributing to Development** to be held in Vienna, Austria, from **30 May to 1 June 2017**. Approximately 400 participants from IAEA Member States and organizations are expected to attend the conference.

The year 2017 will mark the 60th anniversary of the establishment of the IAEA. The International Conference on the IAEA Technical Cooperation Programme: Sixty Years and Beyond — Contributing to Development provides an ideal opportunity to take stock of what has been achieved through the technical cooperation (TC) programme and to demonstrate how the programme can best contribute to the attainment of the Sustainable Development Goal (SDGs) in Member States.

The conference is an occasion for Member States and other partners to explore innovative means to further develop partnerships with other UN and regional organizations, financial institutions, non-traditional donors and the private sector, in order to enhance delivery of the TC programme.

An exhibition is planned on the margins of the conference for Member States and partners to showcase achievements, success stories and partnerships (existing and potential).

Each exhibition space is 6m² (3x2m) and will be offered free of charge including 1 table (80x160cm), 2 chairs and 1 Poster Board.

In order to give the exhibition a professional look, it is nevertheless recommended that exhibitors rent a professional booth with walls, electricity, lights and/or furniture from an outside stand builder (contacts will be provided later).

The IAEA does not charge an exhibitor fee; however, partners wishing to take advantage of the opportunity to exhibit are encouraged to make a voluntary contribution to the IAEA in support of the conference. The contribution would be utilized to cover costs directly related to the organization of the conference. Voluntary contributions will be acknowledged during the conference.
