### **Information for Exhibitors**

#### **General Information**

The first International Conference on the IAEA Technical Cooperation Programme: Sixty Years and Beyond – Contributing to Development, to be held in Vienna, Austria, from 30 May to 1 June 2017, offers Member States, TC programme partners, development banks, sponsors and commercial vendors the opportunity to participate in exhibitions.

#### **Exhibition A: The Impact and Achievements of the IAEA's Technical Cooperation Programme**

This exhibition will present the concrete impact of the IAEA's technical cooperation programme in Member States. Exhibitions are expected to showcase project achievements, success stories and impact, with specific reference to the achievement of development objectives such as the Sustainable Development Goals.

Member States exhibitors participating in Exhibition A are requested to present a concrete theme or themes: agriculture, health, water, the environment, energy, industrial applications or safety. Booths in this exhibition should be interactive and results oriented, and should demonstrate how nuclear technology and the IAEA's technical cooperation programme have assisted in socioeconomic development. Member State exhibits should highlight project achievements and impacts.

Member States assigned to this exhibition will be provided with a 6 m<sup>2</sup> booth. Modalities and more information will be sent directly to exhibitors in due course.

#### **Exhibition B: Cooperation and Partnerships for Development**

This exhibition invites Member States, UN partners, development banks, sponsors and commercial vendors to present their experiences in the peaceful application of nuclear science and technology, and their cooperation with the IAEA's technical cooperation programme.

Member States taking part in Exhibition B will be provided with space, a table, two chairs and a poster board at no cost. Participants are encouraged to bring their own exhibition stands, or to hire suitable booths from an external contractor.

## A Green TC Conference

The IAEA will be seeking official Green Meeting certification for this conference. This means that the IAEA will keep the ecological impact of the conference as low as possible.
