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2002 to 2003- Radiation Protection Audit in Radiotherapy Centres

- 5 Radiotherapy centres for a population of 140 million, i.e. 1 machine to 28 million
- About 100,000 new cases are diagnosed/yr
- Cancer register not updated since 1999
- Services are poor and serve poor patients
- Affluent patients seek treatment abroad

Personnel

- Inadequate number of cadres
 - ➤ Oncologists/Medical Physicist/Radiographers
- ▼Inadequate level of competence
- ∀ High patient-to-expert ratio in radiotherapy



- **∀**Obsolete
- Second hand, without manuals or parts
- **∀**Poorly maintained
- ▼Unaccredited maintenance group
- ✓ Lack of accessories as against spare parts



Premises

- **∀**Location
- ✓ Little or no shielding materials
- **∀**Re-configuration without drawings
- **∀**Lack of records



Procedure

- ▼Lack of Operational Manual
- **✓** Lack of Radiation protection programme
- **✓** Lack of Quality Assurance Manual
- ▼Lack of Radiological Emergency Plan



Management

- ✓ Lack of structured communication channel between management and the operating unit
- ✓ Lack of programme for equipment maintenance and replacement
- ➤ Lack of financial plan budget for the operation and maintenance of the facilities
- ✓ Lack of commitment from management to radiation protection and safety
- ✓ Inadequate communication between management and facility owners.
