INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT THE EXTENDED SYNOPSIS

The extended synopsis (maximum 800 words) should be submitted using the IAEA's web browser based, password protected file submission system, named LISA. Submissions can be made as of 25 October 2004; the deadline for submission of the extended synopses is **3 December 2004**.

An initial password is required to access the LISA system. Please send an email with the subject line "LISA/ACC 2005" requesting the password along with your contact details to the address: physics@iaea.org. The LISA website address is: http://www.iaea.org/cgi-bin/lisa-ACC/start. Instructions on how to produce PDF files will be available on the ACC 2005 web site.

LISA will check the uploaded PDF file for file consistency. Should there be an inconsistency LISA will advise where the problem lies and a revised file should be submitted. Please keep in mind the maximum limit of 10 uploads per contribution.

A sample extended synopsis is attached. The extended synopsis should comply with the following format:

Page size: A4 (297 mm by 210 mm) – vertical orientation

Full margins (left/right/top/bottom): 25 mm

Layout: single-spaced, one additional line between paragraphs

Alignment: left

Font: Times New Roman only Title: 14-point size, bold Authors: 12-point size

Affiliation and e-mail address: 12-point size

Text: 12-point size

Length: maximum 2 pages
