**FIELD TRIP:
23 May 2003**

The excursion is sponsored by the City of Vienna and is free of charge to Symposium participants (except for an optional Cable Car ride). Schedule:

- 08.00 depart by coach from the side street parallel to the Wagramerstrasse (outside the VIC)
- 10.00 visit the water-supply-museum in Kaiserbrunn
- 11.30 Lunch (Seminarparkhotel Hirschwang)
- 13.30 for those feeling energetic: walk the "Wasserleitungsweg" in the beautiful Höllental (gorge) for approximately 1½ hours (good walking shoes required)
- OR
- mount the Rax mountain by cable car (optional; ticket for E13.90 to be purchased by participants) there would be time to enjoy the view, take a small walk and possibly a coffee on the Rax plateau

- 17.30 estimated arrival in Vienna
