Conference Posters:

The size of the poster boards is: 1m wide by 1,80 m high. The posters should thus be formatted 80 cm wide and 1,10 m high.

Accommodations:

Accommodation is available at the Hotel Torremayor at a special rate of US\$ 50 for single and double rooms. 50 rooms have been blocked for conference participants at this hotel. Once this hotel capacity is full, participants will be located by the Hotel Torremayor's management in other hotels of similar category in the vicinity to the Conference premises.

Transportation from airport:
