The ACV can be reached directly from the U1 Underground Station Kaisermuehlen - Vienna International Centre. Please use exit AUSTRIA CENTRE VIENNA - Schüttaustrasse (NOT VIENNA INTERNATIONAL CENTRE). If you come by car, parking is possible at the ACV.

Registration:
